#### Homework

Homework is set on Google Classroom on a **Monday** and should be submitted by 6pm on the following **Sunday**. Each week, on the day the homework is set, I will discuss the tasks set so all children know what to do. The work set will always be based on something we have learnt about in class.

Homework this term will consist of the following:

- A weekly maths activity on Google Classroom.
- A weekly reading or grammar activity on Google Classroom.
- An oracy text for the children to rehearse and learn ready for a whole-class performance on Fridays.



## Take-Away Homework

This term the take-away homework is based on our topic 'The Tudors'. The take-away menu and letter will provide more information on this.

## **Spellings**

Spellings are set on Mondays on Spelling Shed and tested on Fridays on Spelling Shed. They practise this for 15 minutes daily at school and we encourage the children to practise at home too, if able. Their spelling score will be written into their reading diary on their subsequent reading day.

## Reading

Books are changed on their reading day. Please ensure your child brings their reading record to school every day, indicating the reading they have done during the week. If your child has read other books at home, please record this in the back of their reading records. The children are awarded team points based on how often they read, so it is important that this is written in the record, and brought in for us to see.

## **English**

*In writing this term, we will focus on the following:* 

- Imaginary Stories
- Persuasive Writing
- Newspaper Reports
- Plays by Shakespeare



## **Discovery Curriculum**

Our Discovery topic this term will be The Tudors. Most of our history, geography and art lessons will link to this topic, as well as some of our reading and writing sessions.

Some of the things we will be learning about include:

- Who the Tudors were– looking at Henry VIII and his family tree
- How people dressed in the Tudor times
- Tudor portraits
- What life was like for children in the Tudor times
- Places near by that were significant in the Tudor times

## Maths

*In Maths this term we will focus on the following:* 

- Fractions
- Co-ordinates
- Statistics

In June, the children will be sitting the Multiplication Times Tables Check. Any practice you child can do on TTRockstars would be greatly beneficial!



## PE

PE will continue to take place on Wednesday afternoons. Children should continue to come to school in their PE kits on Wednesdays.
