<u>Homework</u>

Year 1

This half-term we will be focusing on reading as our main homework task.

<u>Reading</u>

Please try to read with your child every day and record this in their yellow reading record books. As well as the books that come home in your child's wallets, you are of course encouraged to read and record other books that you may have at home. Reading books will be changed each week **but only if** they have been recorded as read in the yellow books.

<u>Phonics</u>

Each week, the children will bring home a phonics workbook which they have used during the week. Please share these with your child as they will show which phonemes they have been learning so that you can support them in reading, recognising and spelling these sounds. A bookmark which includes some words with the phonemes that children have been learning will also be sent home.

<u>Spellings</u>

Spelling lists to learn at home may be sent home later in the year.

Take Away Homework

This term the takeaway homework is mainly based on learning across all subject areas that will take place this term. Please choose a task that interests you to share at the end of term.

Details of takeaway homework tasks can be found on a separate document. Please help your child to select a task that appeals to them and that they can present to the class at the end of term.



<u>English</u>

In English lessons this term, we will be concentrating on sentence structure and the use of simple punctuation. We will also study a range of fiction and non-fiction texts.

We will develop our:

 \cdot Composition of sentences both orally and written

 \cdot Use of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

 \cdot Use of correct tense- simple past or present

• Use of exclamation and guestion marks

· Use of adjectives.

· Use of coordinating and subordinating conjunctions



<u>PE</u>

PE will be on a Wednesday and Thursday. Please ensure that your child comes dressed in their school PE kits on these days. They will stay in their PE kits all day. Earrings should not be worn and long hair should be tied back. Please make sure all your child's clothes are named. School PE kits will be provided if children are not in correct clothing.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths this term we will be working on:

• number and place value,

 \cdot addition and subtraction and number bonds

· shape, position and direction and measurement

The children will receive a healthy snack every day to enjoy at playtime. They should also bring in a drink of **water** in a labelled bottle
