Homework

The children will be provided with reading, Spelling Shed and TT Rockstar as their homework. Usernames and passwords for these will be stuck into the front of the yellow reading journals.

Reading

Reading records will be checked once a week; the day will be specified inside the front cover of your child's reading record. However, we do ask the children to have their reading records in school with them every day as they will be reading with adults throughout the week.

<u>Spellings</u>

Spellings will be set on Mondays on Spelling Shed and tested on Fridays on Spelling Shed. Children will have time to practise on Spelling Shed in school but please allow time at home too. Their spelling score will be written into their reading diary.

<u>English</u>

In English this term we will focus on the following:

- Narrative based on the book 'The Secret of Black Roak'.
- Non-fiction: How to wash a Wooly Mammoth
- Non-fiction: Skeleton and Muscles

Through these units and in specific SPaG lessons, Year 3
grammar, sentence and punctuation objectives will be taught.

Maths

In maths this term, the focus will be on the following:

- Breaking down addition and subtraction steps (continuing)
- Column addition
- 2,4 and 8 times tables
- Scaling number facts by 10
- Column subtraction
- Preparing for fractions part whole relationships

The children will also have opportunities to enhance their maths skills and practise basic skills on TT Rockstars.

Curriculum Subjects for the Autumn Term:

- GLF Wider Curriculum (incorporating history, geography and design technology): 'How have engineers found solutions to geographical challenges?'
- RE: 'Christianity'
- Life Skills: Dreams and Goals and 'Healthy Me'
- Computing: 'Sequence in music' and 'Branching databases'

PE will take place on **Tuesday** and **Thursday**. Children should continue to come to school with their PE kits on. **School PE** kits will be provided if children are not in correct clothing.
