Homework

Homework in year 1 will continue to consist of daily reading. Each week they will continue to take home their phonic workbook and phonic spelling bookmark. Please look through this with your child and practice reading and writing the words on the bookmark that includes the phonemes of the week that we have learnt.

Reading

The children are making fantastic progress with their reading. Reading books will continue to be changed on a **Thursday**. Please continue to fill in your child's reading record with a comment. **Please ensure your child is bringing in their reading wallet daily**.

Majority of children will now be moving away from individual reading to an adult at school and will be moving onto guided group reading which consists of a small group read to further develop their reading skills as the children are now reading fluently.

Weekly Fluency Passage

A weekly fluency passage will continue to be sent out for your child to practice at home. We will also be practising daily in class and then they will perform it during assembly on **Thursdays** which they love! This is a great opportunity for your child to practice their expression.

Spellings

Please continue working on spelling the Year 1 Common exception words which are stuck at the back of your child's yellow reading record. They are making great progress with this and have learnt to spell lots of new words. Once your child is secure in spelling the words, I will highlight each word off the list


Take Away Homework
