<u>Homework</u>

Year 1

Homework in year 1 will continue to consist of daily reading and practising spelling the common exception words at the back of your child's yellow reading records. Each week they will continue to take home their phonic workbook and phonic spelling bookmark. Please look through this with your child and practice reading and writing the words on the bookmark that includes the phonemes of the week that we have learnt.

<u>Reading</u>

The children are making fantastic progress with their reading. Reading books will continue to be changed on their reading day. Please continue to fill in your child's reading record with a comment once they have read. **Please** ensure your child is bringing in their reading wallet daily.

The majority of children have now come away from individual daily reads and are participating in a guided group read once a week which supports fluency and comprehension.

<u>Weekly Fluency Passage</u>

A weekly fluency passage will continue to be sent out for your child to practice at home. We will also be practising daily in class and then they will perform it during assembly on **Thursdays** which they love! This is a great opportunity for your child to practice their expression.

<u>Spellings</u>

Please continue working on spelling the Year 1 common exception words which are stuck at the back of your child's yellow reading record. They are making great progress with these and have learnt to spell lots of the words. Once your child is secure in spelling the words, I will highlight each word off the list.

Take Away Homework

This term the takeaway homework is based on all subject areas as well as our wider curriculum topics 'How do scientists compare animals?' and 'Cultures and Celebrations from around the world!'. Please choose a task that interests you to share in the last week of Year 1!

<u>English</u>

In English this term, we will focus on the following:

- Non-Fiction Persuasion: Ice Planet Adventure
- Narrative: Grandad's Island
- Narrative: Wombat goes Walkabout

We will also be continuing to develop our stamina for writing, using the correct punctuation including capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.

<u>PE</u>

PE will continue to be on **Tuesday afternoons and Wednesday mornings**. Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit on these days and all items of clothing are labelled. This term we will be doing:

- Athletics
- Net and Wall games
- Team building
- Invasion games
