However, we do ask the children to have their reading records in school with them every day as they will be reading with adults throughout the week. Spellings will be set on Mondays on Spelling Shed and tested on Fridays on Spelling Shed. Children will have time to practise on Spelling Shed in school but please allow time at home too. Their spelling score will be written into their reading diary.

<ul> <li>In English this term we will focus on the following:</li> <li>Narrative based on the book 'The Incredible book Eating Boy'</li> <li>Explanation: How a Robot Dog Works</li> <li>Poem: I asked the boy who couldn't see</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>GLF Wider Curriculum (incorporating history, geography and design technology): 'What do all plants have and need in order to survive?'</li> <li>RE: Sikhism and 'What is the "Golden Rule" and why do so many people live by it?'</li> <li>Life Skills: 'Relationships' and Changing Me'</li> <li>Computing: 'Programming' and 'Creating media'</li> </ul>
Through these units and in specific SPaG lessons, Year 3 grammar, sentence and punctuation objectives will be taught.	<u>PE</u> Swimming will take the place of our <b>Monday</b> PE session. PE will take place on <b>Thursday</b> . Children should only come into school in their PE kits on the <b>Thursday</b> . School PE kits will be provided if children are not in correct clothing.
