Homework

The children will be provided with Century Education, reading, Spelling Shed and TT Rockstars as their homework. Usernames and passwords for these are stuck into the front of the yellow reading journals.

Take Away Homework

This term the takeaway homework is based on our 'Farming through history' topic, our 'Cultures and Celebrations from Around the World' topic and will include learning from across all subject areas that will take place this term. Please choose a task that interests you to share at the end of term.

Take Away celebration week will be the last week of Year 5!

Reading

Reading records will be checked once a week; the day will be specified inside the front cover of your child's reading record. However, we do ask the children to have their reading records in school with them every day as they will be reading with adults throughout the week. Children will receive house points for the reading that is recorded in their diary. I am so impressed with the children's' attitude towards reading and the growing love that I am seeing. Thank you for your support and encouragement with this.

Spellings *Spellings will be set on Mondays on Spelling Shed and tested on Fridays on Spelling Shed. They practise this daily at school and we encourage the children to practise at home too if able. Their spelling score will be written into their reading diary on their reading day.*

English

In English this term we will focus on the following :

- *Non-fiction: 'Non-chronological report: Emperor Penguins'*
- *Narrative based on the book 'Gorilla'.*
- *Non-fiction: 'Balanced Argument: Screen Use'*

Through these units and in specific SPaG lessons, Year 5 grammar, sentence and punctuation objectives will be taught.

Maths

In maths this term, the focus will be on the following :

- *Factors, prime and composites*
- *Multiplying whole number and fractions*
- *Finding equivalent fractions and simplifying*
- *Linking fractions, decimals and percentages*
- *Converting unit of measurement*
- *Properties of shapes, including angles*
- *Transformation*

The children will also have opportunities to enhance their maths skills and practise basic skills on TT Rockstars and during basic skill sessions.

Curriculum Subjects:

- *GLF Wider Curriculum (incorporating science, history, geography, art and design technology): 'The way things grow affects the way we live. Support or Challenge?' and 'Cultures and Celebrations from Around the World'*
- *RE: 'Christianity' and 'What does it mean to have a good life?'*
- *Life Skills: 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me'*
- *Computing: 'Vector Drawing' and 'Video Editing'*

PE
